


# **YEAR 11.... FREE USEFUL APPS**

MyStudyLife is a calendar app that lets you build timetables to keep track of exams.

If your organisational skills aren't great, this app could be the answer!

MyStudyLife lets you assign tasks with reminders so that you don't MyStudyLife forget a thing!!!





Forest uses the Pomodoro technique to help you stay focused and avoid distractions from your phone.

When the timer goes off, you plant a tree, and if you close the app during the time allotted, 20 or 25 minutes, the tree dies!

Watching your forest grow with the more Pomodoros you finish without getting sidetracked can be rewarding. The Pomodoro technique follows a basic pattern of 25 minutes of studying followed by a five-minute break.

The best part about this app is that the trees or plants you grow here are also planted in real forests. This way, you make yourself productive and contribute towards making the earth greener.

# **SKILLSBUILDER**

### Developing employment skills with Skillsbuilder

Skillsbuilder is a free online self-assessment tool that can be used by students, families, or employees, who want to improve their soft skills. The courses are useful for developing life skills and preparing for the world of work. Employers are increasingly focusing on the soft skills that students (in particular) have, as these are just as important when succeeding in the workplace as technical skills or knowledge. We are also seeing employers embed Skillsbuilder into their recruitment framework and language, so being aware of skills builder can only benefit your child in the long run.

Students and their families can sign up for free and access the training materials aimed at developing skills, such as, communication, teamwork, creativity and leadership to name a few. Each skill is condensed into smaller manageable steps that make sure understanding and progression work together.



### HomeZone

Families can work together build their essential skills. By doing so, you can improve on; social and emotional well-being, learning and academic outcomes, careers and opportunities. It is free to sign up to the platform and you will receive weekly emails with a fun family task to complete.

PE jumper with school logo (optional)


