With **114** responses, representing approximately 14% of our 840 students, we are encouraged by the strong engagement from our community.

Your feedback plays a critical role in shaping the environment at St John Bosco College, and your contributions help to ensure we continue to provide a safe, inclusive, and happy experience for all students.



RESULTS

We are pleased to share some of the positive highlights from the survey results:

94%

of parents agreed or strongly agreed that their child is happy at St John Bosco College, with many expressing confidence in the nurturing environment we strive to provide.

96%

of parents felt their child is safe at the school, reflecting our ongoing efforts to ensure a secure and supportive RUAH atmosphere for all students.

94%

of parents also praised the school's focus on behaviour, with the majority agreeing that we ensure pupils are well-behaved, contributing to a respectful and disciplined school community.

95%

of respondents acknowledged that the school teaches the value of respect, a key part of our ethos, which we continually work to reinforce among students.

94%

of parents said their child has made friends at school, and 87% felt that their child is included and part of the school community, demonstrating the welcoming and inclusive environment we aim to foster.
